### **Summary of Meeting:**

The UL 2900-2-1 TC chair discussed how the original and current proposal was trying to incorporate the *UL 2900-1: Standard for Safety, Software Cybersecurity for Network-Connectable Products, Part 1: General Requirements* into the *UL 2900-2-1*. This incorporation of UL 2900-1 into UL 2900-2-1 is to make UL 2900-2-1 a stand-alone document, as the UL 2900-2 standards' series focus mainly on specific product classes. The TC chair also mentioned that the comments received during that proposal were technical and mostly about how to revamp or update the UL 2900-2-1, while the (incorporation) proposal's original intent was to not be technical. Staff asked what the normal procedure was to incorporate a general requirements document into a specific product class requirements document. Some discussion then followed how the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) and other risk management documents could be incorporated into the 2900-2-1. The TC then briefly reviewed the comments received again but then agreed to discuss them in more detail at a later date. The TC then agreed to move forward with the current proposal first (incorporation of 2900-1 into 2900-2-1), propose any comments on that incorporation, then focus on the 2900-2-1 and technical details revamp later.

### **Next Steps:**

The current proposal will be sent out for another preliminary review, and additional Task Groups and a later meeting date will be set up if needed.
