Summary of Meeting:

The Technical Harmonization Committee convened to review progress on comparing sections of the standard and developing draft language.

Key Discussion Points:

- **Review of Standards Comparison:**
One member presented a detailed comparison of a section of requirements across the two standards and highlighted specific areas needing attention. In particular, some sections do not completely align because relevant requirements may be elsewhere in one standard. This information will need to be combined thoroughly and effectively.
- **Harmonization Methodology:**
The committee discussed best approaches to developing draft requirements and shared methods used by members assigned to develop different sections of the harmonized standard. In general, the most stringent requirements from each standard will be combined and the committee will evaluate how to incorporate requirements that are not shared.
- **References:**
When the standard references country specific documents, the harmonized standard can refer to both. Referenced requirements will remain applicable based on their respective country.
- **Terminology:**
The committee discussed language and terminology such as using “alarm” versus “device.” Other considerations included spelling conventions between the U.S. and Canada.

Next Steps:

- Members will continue comparing the documents and developing draft language for the harmonized standard.
