SUMMARY OF MEETING:

Members discussed a conspicuous location of warning label inside the drawer on the side panel in the front half of the drawer. Several members expressed concerns on: fitting multiple languages on a single label, size of the drawer side may not be sufficient. Staff expressed the importance of warning label location on their effectiveness. The task group has not reached consensus on height requirement of the label although they are open to the addition of a note in F2057 labeling section which refers to the appropriate height for visibility. The TG discussed options for how to incorporate UL 1678 standard as the benchmark for manufacturers producing CSUs that support a TV.
