SUMMARY OF MEETING: Mike Steinwachs, subcommittee chair and task group lead, conducted the meeting. The task group (TG):

- 1. Discussed the history of adding electrical wording for battery compartment containment copied from F2088 Infant Swing standard. This issue was presented at the June 2017 infant inclined sleep products subcommittee meeting, where a number of concerns were raised. The task group was asked to further consider this issue.**
- 2. The task group discussed the new proposed performance and testing requirements for electrical components presented by the subcommittee chair**

based on previous task group conference calls. The TG agreed that the new proposal is appropriate for the incidents and style of products that have battery compartments.

3. The subcommittee chair will present this proposed ballot to the subcommittee at the January 23rd meeting.
