July 7, 2017 ballot results from the above and on ground pool ladder were discussed. The ballot results relating to ladders received 8 votes for and 1 vote against. The committee is meeting to revise and reballot the language, if necessary.

Language for type A ladders includes removal, active or passive features intended to limit access of children. Language for type B ladders are similar to type A ladders but have built in features intended to limit access by unattended children under the age of 5. (Type b ladders may be heavier than the type A ladders). Safety sign associated the Type B are required to provide how to engage the access limiting feature (typically a passive device) or removal when the pool is not is use. The sign shall include the steps required to engage the access limiting feature.

Water clarity definitions were discussed.

APSP swimming pool safety brochure information was discussed.

Ballot language circulation is expected in the spring/April of 2018.
