SUMMARY OF MEETING: Paul Ware (subcommittee/task group chair) started the conference call by asking if there were any comments regarding the proposed ballot for soap solution. CPSC staff asked about adding a statement of "or equivalent" to the examples. TG decided that it was better to keep the current solution description/formula in the standard and say "equivalent to the formula and provide examples." The TG then discussed the fixture drawings and agreed the testing labs would confirm their fixture measurements one more time before any other changes are made. The subcommittee chair sent the TG about 11 draft

ballot items to update the standard. There was discussion about one ballot item recommending deletion of two CPSC regulations from the reference section because they are not specifically mentioned in the standard. The TG decided it was okay to delete. The TG will review all of the proposed ballot items and get back to subcommittee chair as soon as possible with any changes. The meeting adjourned.
