**SUMMARY OF MEETING: The meeting was to discuss updates to the F1313-11, Standard Specification for Volatile N-Nitrosamine Levels in Rubber Nipples on Pacifiers as part of the ASTM's required periodic review of standards. Issues raised included that the standard states that it applies to eight chemicals, but lists only seven specific substances; possibly aligning with the European standard for these products that refers to a different list of chemicals and a different way of defining the limit; and the need to update the out-of-date test methods. Participants agreed to focus on the needed test method update. One participant volunteered to pull some information together on test methods for discussion by the work group in a future teleconference.**
