2. Goal Discussion

The object of the call was to set goals for improvement ahead of the first post-transition report which will become available mid-year. We looked at prior research in hopes of obtaining some insight as to what would be appropriate goals. Greg Rogers reviewed some of his past work in evaluating standards. No consensus was achieved on goals and it was agreed that no consensus was likely. It was agreed to share with the full subcommittee that we did not believe a goal was achievable or necessarily necessary after good faith efforts to find one. It was agreed to save (and build) the bibliography of other evaluative studies and that the committee could discuss further action after the post-transition reports become available in June.
