SUMMARY OF MEETINGS:

This was a teleconference of the Label task group of the ASTM F15.42 subcommittee on furniture safety. The meeting was hosted by Blake Gudbaur of Delta Children furniture.

The first item of discussion was the language used for CSUs intended to support a television. There was a general agreement on specific language and to add an informative Note or Appendix. This section would be informative, not mandatory.

Next item of discussion was label location. Some ideas were thrown around about where the labels should be located but some members stated that there are products (like a CSU with wicker baskets instead of drawers or drawers with flocked lining) that would not be able to allow a label.

Next item dealt with font size, specifically, should font size be specified capital letter height instead of points. Other label specs such as layout and conformity to ANSI Z535.4 were also discussed.
