SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The TG discussed test methodology language to clarify the loaded drawer test position. The discussion centered around the length of drawer extension, final outstop or 2/3 operational slide length. Several members raised the question if the drawer slide does not extend 2/3 of operational slide length by design how would a test be performed. Also, if an outstop is present language should address opening to a point before drawer removal. The definition of outstop was also discussed and change should be considered as part of task group's recommendations. The discussion centered around the term "limits" in the outstop definition. The TG will provide several drafts of language and discuss through email before the next meeting.
