SUMMARY OF MEETING: Paul Ware (subcommittee/task group chair) started the conference call by explaning the purpose of the call was to review an additional 8 ballots he plans to present to the subcommittee in May. The task group (TG) then went through the ballots related to warnings, stability, latching and locking, static load, suction cups, attachment components, rationale section, and leg openings. He explained that the warnings were updated to reflect Ad Hoc wording. The other ballots were minor updates, nothing of significance. The TG discussed whether it was necessary to specify material of the shoulder probe as sanded wood, or if it can be left up to the testing lab the material used? TG agreed to

have a conference call with CPSC and testing labs to consider change of material for probe. There were no other comments for the proposed ballots, so Mr. Ware will prepare them for presentation during the May Subcommittee meeting. The meeting adjourned at 10:30am.
