F15.09 Home Playground Equipment

There was lots of discussion about potential changes to the public playground standard about the responsibility of verifying that the surfacing was installed correctly by the manufacturer, installer, or owner.

The subcommittee discussed about take out field test out of this standard and make it a separate standard

In regards to impact drop location there was discussion about a definition about what determines the least favorable location that needs to be tested. → TUV will propose language and data at the next meeting

Section 12.2.2 shall be removed. Per x2.3 interval between impacts- variations in the time needed to conduct the test result in variable levels of recovery of the material during the room temp test. This variation is accentuated in non-room temperature test by the addition of changing temp condition within the sample to the variable recovery of the material. Multiple drops are necessary at the same location for a representative test.
