SUMMARY OF MEETING: The working group discussed Frank Gibb's and Al Kaufman's edits to the sound-producing toys definitions, requirements, and test methods. Specific items discussed include: changing "push/pull toys" to "push or pull toys" throughout the document, moving language on testing toys that fit into multiple categories from section 8.20.1.5 to 8.20.2, changing the wording in the exemptions list, changing the description of batteries in section 8.20.1.5, changing "noise" to "sound" except for "background noise," and changing rationale for changes to reflect both ASTM and CPSC positions. Working group members will submit specific comments and edits to Al Kaufman. New draft will be circulated to the working group for review and discussion before being sent to

the full subcommittee for comment.
