SUMMARY OF MEETING: The task group discussed how to clarify "a conspicuous location when in use." Discussion included whether an abbreviated warning should be allowable regardless of unit design or only when design does not allow for placement; allowable locations for labels, such as inside an open door and other non-internal locations (e.g. an open storage area), and methods to determine visibility; how to address labeling for units with baskets and trays; and "line of sight" best practices. The chair and other group members will compose draft language for review at the next meeting, planned for mid-September.
