SUMMARY OF MEETING:

CPSC staff listened by phone in the regular meeting of the California Bureau of Electronic and Appliance Repair, Home Furnishings, and Thermal Insulation (BEARHFTI) hearing on a regulation change to remove The requirement for any furniture in California to comply with Technical Bulletin 133 (TB 133), Flammability Test Procedure for Seating Furniture for Use in Public Occupancies. The hearing was a public meeting where participants had an opportunity to provide oral public comments on the proposal to remove the requirements to comply with TB 133 in the state of California. Some participants in person and on the teleconference voiced support for the regulation change, no oral comments were made in opposition. CPSC staff provided no comment and no opinion. Barring significant written public comments, BEARHFTI plans to make the regulation change effective January 1, 2019.
