SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The task group's (TG's) focus is to clarify the scope of products that the standard is intended to cover. The Minimum Height TG has been absorbed into this group. The discussion centered on how a Clothing Storage Unit (CSU)/Clothing Storage Furniture can be determined using a decision tree approach around factors similar to the CPSIA children's product guidelines. The TG identified several product features and dimensions that would help clarify what the standard is intended to cover. The TG chair will draft a decision tree and solicit comments from the rest of the TG. Several members emphasized the need to define nightstand and differentiate it from CSU.
