**SUMMARY OF MEETING:** Representatives of Lint Sentry provided a history of their involvement on the issue of dryer fires. They discussed California AB 1411 and its resulting report, which they indicated recommended requiring clothes dryers have an audible and visual warning device to alert the consumer to lint build up in the burner compartment. They expressed concern that lint build up is a hazard that is not well known. They want UL2158 amended to require a warning device on the appliance.
