### MEETING SUMMARY:

CPSC staff were part of the non-voting public audience to hear the technical comments on ICC swimming pool and spa code. Many of these proposal are intended to increase safety in the design.

The International Code Council (ICC) received proposed code changes for International Swimming pool and Spa code (ISPSC) submissions in March 2018; they were reviewed in a public hearing in April of 2018. Some of those ISPSC changes were accepted in a vote by the panel in April. There was a public comment period requested any additional information in those proposed changes.

This public hearing presented the information in the proposal technical comments in code for consideration in altering the original proposed changes. Some of these comments discussion included swim out and building material definitions. Also discussed were barriers during construction of pools, and directional openings of doorways, which was previously undefined in the code.

### Next Steps:

CPSC staff have no action items. Following this hearing, the results of the change proposals voting are reviewed at the committee and confirmed with the ICC Board for new ISPSP code publication.
