**SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

The subcommittee had various task group meetings and formed an additional task group for amusement park play areas. There were no substantial updates from the F1193 (Standard Practice for Quality, Manufacture, and Construction of Amusement Rides and Devices) task group. The F770 (Standard Practice for Quality, Manufacture, and Construction of Amusement Rides and Devices) discussed the development of an umbrella standard and a new task group to review the references and dates in existing standards. EVO I and EVO II both held task group meetings.

EVO I – Task group chair reviewed current plan to address corrosion hazards. The latest ballots were intended to address these issues. Updates to the standard are progressing, however, another round of balloting is needed based on persuasive negatives. After completion, the task group will begin to address aging/orphan rides. There was additional discussions on the transfer of hazard mitigation information between designers, manufacturers, and owner/operators. This included existing information in manuals in addition to ways of addressing corrosion potential.

EVO II – Ballot for F1193 required editing some language to address ballot negatives related to specific wording. This included updating the language related to retention of documents. New language will include specific time frames and eliminate open ended language.
