SUMMARY OF MEETING: Steven Anzaroot (subcommittee/task group chair) started the conference call by explaining that during the last subcommittee meeting someone raised a question as to how mini-cribs that convert to toddler beds should be handled since they don't fall in the scope of toddler beds based on mattress size. S. Anzaroot shared information about how toddler beds are defined in UK and France compared to ASTM. The other standards allow larger mattresses. K. Walsh indicated that while this size product would not meet the standard, his testing lab would likely test to general juvenile products requirements and acknowledge that it does not meet the toddler bed definition.

S. Anzaroot asked if this item should be shared with the Ad Hoc Scope committee for monitoring and put on the toddler bed memory sheet. The task group members agreed. S. Anzaroot will share with Ad Hoc Scope committee and monitor incidents. Meeting adjourned at 2:25pm.
