The connected products working group held this initial teleconference as an exploratory meeting to gauge interest and to possibly draft an ASTM standard for internet connected products. A draft ASTM standard was provided as a starting point for group discussion. The group supported drafting a standard for connected devices. Mr. Mays also referenced the whitepaper recently released by Commissioner Kaye on "Considerations for Consumer Product Safety." The working group determined that safety of products would be the focus of the standard and that privacy issues would not be directly addressed although it was believed that by addressing the safety many of the privacy issues would be addressed.

CPSC staff discussed internal efforts to look at their data. The present UL standards were also discussed for UL certified products. CPSC staff believe that a similar approach is needed to address ASTM certified products and that the NIST 8228 framework should be applied as needed. CPSC staff volunteered to draft the initial scope language for the working group's consideration.
