SUMMARY OF MEETING: Julia Costello conducted the meeting:

- 1. Ms. Costello stated that in the last ballot there were 3 negative votes related to Ad Hoc language.**
- 2. One negative related to a warning that conflicts for products that are cradle swings and bassinets.**
- 3. One negative relates to restraints because a cradle swing in the "non-swing" mode is a bassinet and bassinets are not allowed to have restraints.**
- 4. One negative related to battery markings on the product. The commenter recommended waiting until the Ad Hoc Language group present**

recommendations.

5. Because the members who submitted the negative votes were not on the task group call, Ms. Costello decided to present the issues to the subcommittee meeting in May for discussion.
