MEETING SUMMARY:

Ms. Stuart summarized the March 11, 2019 meeting where CPSC staff proposed keeping “serious injury” in the warning label because it is a possible outcome that should be warned against. The other working group members wanted to change the safety alert symbol and “WARNING” signal word to “CAUTION.” Then, the other working group members requested incident data to support keeping the “/!\ WARNING Serious injury can occur if swallowed” and possibly adding “or placed inside any part of the body (e.g. nose or ear).” CPSC staff stated that they would conduct a search for supporting data (In-depth Investigation reports and incident reports) for non-lithium batteries for the past 5 years for the next ANSI C18 meeting on June 12 and June 13 in Denver, CO.
