MEETING SUMMARY:

The agenda for this meeting and previous meeting minutes from the August 9th, 2019 meeting were approved.

A draft terminology section with the following definitions and their issues were discussed below:

“Connected Product” definition was discussed, as it was the same wording in the body of the standard and originally supplied by CPSC.

“Connected controller” definition currently needs wording and “Foreseeable misuse” definitions were also discussed for clarity and correctness.

“Safety” definition was discussed such as exact meaning of terms such as prevention and whether term “freedom from unacceptable risk” should be used. J. Howell will look at past definitions used in existing standards and send out a new definition list.

Questions also arose whether certain definitions should be used both in the Definition list and the body of the Standard or only one time.

The next meeting is scheduled for October 18th, Friday, 3 p.m.
