### Meeting Summary

The group discussed different features that could potentially be used to determine if a product would be in scope of F2057 as a Clothing Storage Unit (CSU). In particular how do we distinguish a nightstand from a clothing storage unit? Several suggestions were discussed including volume measurements of a drawer or the entire unit, weight of the unit, material such as plastic. Several members expressed concern with repeatability of conducting the measurements and calculations. The group is trying to gather more dimensional data on nightstands to better inform the “dimensional fence” of a nightstand. There was also additional discussion about the three prong approach which uses Marketing of the product, Naming of the product, and Common recognition of the product to determine if it falls under F2057.
