**SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

The purpose of the meeting was to continue to discuss revising the warning section of ASTM F406 to be consistent with the Ad Hoc recommendations for the warning sections of similar standards.

Topics of discussion continued from the last meeting and focused on the Ad Hoc statement that allows for placing labels in a secondary, non-conspicuous location when space is prohibited, and how that would affect existing products. Specifically, the task group questioned if warnings placed on the underside of the mattress or under the mattress on the mattress support system are considered “conspicuous” or “visible in their entirety.” The task group also discussed changing or adding clarification to the current requirement, which allowed for a secondary, non-conspicuous warning location without restriction to the ad-hoc recommendations, which only allow for a secondary location when space is prohibited. No resolution was reached at this time. Task group members will evaluate examples of current products and continue discussions will continue.
