SUMMARY OF MEETING:

Kate M. Reynolds, MPH from Rocky Mountain POISON & DRUG SAFETY presented on the Liquid Laundry Detergent Packet Exposures Reported to the National Poison Data System (NPDS).

The objective of the presentation was to describe exposures to the liquid laundry detergent packets reported to the NPDS during the post period following the implementation of ASTM standard F3159. This standard prescribes requirements for household Liquid Laundry Detergent Packet safety to help reduce unintentional exposures to the contents of the packets, especially to children through ingestion.

The group briefly discussed the additional measures working group led by Nancy Cowles and the formation of a new working group focused on the scope of the standard to be led by Rachel Weintraub. The subject of the next roundtable was proposed to be on the subject of Senior Safety.
