Summary of Meeting:

This was a meeting of the Storage and Warehousing of Containers and Portable Tanks Committee (FLC-SWC), which is responsible for parts of the NFPA 30, Flammable and Combustible Liquid Code. The meeting was called to address the public comments made to the second revision of the 2021 edition. The committee reviewed approximately 32 public comments and made revisions where agreement was reached.

Two public comments were received on section 9.4.1 (2) which references ASTM F852. One comment asked to remove the reference as ASTM F852 was withdrawn. The second comment asked to update the reference to ASTM F852 as the document is expected to be re-approved by ASTM on August 1, 2019 with a new title encompassing gasoline, diesel, and kerosene containers. The committee voted to keep the reference to ASTM F852 and update the title. Additionally, the committee was asked by Scott Ayers if there would be any issues to adding other voluntary standards for consumer flammable and combustible containers in this section in future editions. No one on the committee raised any objections, but Scott Ayers did note that he is actively working on an ASTM standard for flame mitigation devices on disposable fuel containers and that he expects it to be finalized in time for the next edition revision cycle.

The meeting closed after the public comments were addressed and no other business was introduced.

The next NFPA 30 meeting was not scheduled.
