SUMMARY OF MEETING: Anna Carter conducted the meeting: She explained the purpose of the task group (tg) is to identify primary causes and pattern found in the data. She shared a spreadsheet that she compiled from a variety of sources. She is going to continue compiling older data to her spreadsheet, which only goes back to 2014. There was some discussion about

the different product designs covered in the data. TG discussion also addresses causes of death and asked for definitions of position asphyxia, suffocation, SUIDS, and SIDS. CPSC staff was asked to provide some more detailed comparison data related to angle of product and if rollover occurred, Ms. Kish explained that was probably not something staff could provide. Ms. Carter asked everyone to take some time to look at the data she compiled and be prepared to discuss at next task group meeting. Meeting adjourned at 4:04pm.
