**SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

This meeting was to discuss the title and scope of ASTM F3118, *Standard Consumer Safety Specification for Infant Inclined Sleep Products*.

During the first meeting, the title and scope of the standard was established as the focus of the task group. The chair explained the need to change the standard based on infant inclined sleep product incidents. Topics discussed include the messaging regarding overnight and prolonged sleep and limiting the recommended age range of the product.

Task group members expressed the need for data. The task group wants to review the data and compare other infant products, which have inclined backs. The task group will continue to brainstorm and stay involved in other task group developments.
