SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The goal of this task group meeting was to revise the ballot to allow multiple occupant slings, and account for the testing of such slings, based on the negative votes received during balloting.

The task group chair had prepared a draft for review that addressed the negative notes. The task group went through it and discussed/revised key aspects. In particular, the dynamic test method garnered much discussion and language refinement. The occupant retention test was also discussed, and the task group felt it needed to revise the test method so that it also included a test with two test weights, for slings that allowed two children. During this discussion, the group also discussed several clarifications in the test description, and decided to draft language to clarify the number of test cycles.

Next step is to revise the draft ballot based on the meeting and, if possible, make the next ballot to have results by the subcommittee meeting.
