This meeting was a working task force meeting of the CSA Technical Subcommittee that handles gas grills Z21.58. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss current language and develop new language for the requirements for lp-gas storage in a gas grill enclosure.

The group drafted new language for lp-gas cylinder storage under a gas grill firebox that should remove ambiguity. The group agrees that only one lp-gas cylinder can be in-use and that no portion of a second cylinder can be stored under the firebox in either an upright or horizontal position.

The group drafted definitions in support of the requirements above.
