SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The task group chair presented proposed new language related to the warning label safety symbol and colors, tv-related labels, warnings in instructions, removable warnings, and warning label placement (conspicuity). Discussion included: whether to provide a size requirement for warnings in instructions, specific wording and definitions, the likelihood that a consumer would see a temporary label, split labels (most critical warnings in one location with reference to second label with remainder), and the position of label from top of drawer. In response to discussion about the definition of "address" for warnings, CPSC staff suggested borrowing language from Ad Hoc Committee.

Next steps: The task group chair plans to clean up the language in preparation for balloting.
