Ballot results: The chair went over the last two ballot items, which had already been handled and the revised standard was just published in October 2020.

New Business: A task group was formed to discuss the strangulation hazard scenario that was brought up in the letter from CPSC staff to the infant swing subcommittee. As a rocker and two swings were involved in incidents, staff agrees that the rockers subcommittee should also consider revisions to the requirements, to address the potential hazard.
