This meeting focused on the most recent version of the juvenile products scope chart that contains products where the scope is not obviously defined. The chair went over his planned revisions to the chart:

- Reordering by standard number
- Infant Tents will be addressed in new Infant Sleep Products standard
- Bed sharing products will get a note about subcommittee work
- Infant rockers – will add a sway product that is unpowered and a picture of a toddler rocker without restraints. Both are considered to be in-scope.
- Revision history section added
- Scope formatting guidance will be added

New business – Rocker/Glider

A relatively new product was discussed, and will be under the scope of the swing standard, which now includes motorized gliders.
