SUMMARY OF MEETING:

The task group chair presented suggested language on a design-based set of criteria for distinguishing between units in and out of scope. This language is intended to include nightstands that a reasonable consumer would perceive to be clothing storage units within the scope of the standard.

Discussion included: documenting the changes in the standard, how to handle clear doors intended for display, testing of shallow drawers, providing diagrams and examples to clarify, how to measure drawer volume, and storage behind doors.

Next steps: the task group chair plans to hold another meeting in early January to continue the discussion and review new language.
