Items discussed included a change to larger vent openings in the cabinet; adding requirements for the LP-gas cylinder enclosure for a built-in grill; new requirements for built-in grills with remote LP-gas supply systems; harmonization of US and Canadian standards on gas lighting; recreational table top grills; and hot surface tests. All of the task force items will be considered at the next meeting. The group ran out of time and could not discuss all remaining items on the agenda.
