This was a meeting of CANENA Working Group 12, where the attendees continued working on a proposed update the bi-national standard, UL/CSA 60335-2-89 Edition 1 for refrigeration systems. In addition to this CANENA working group, AHRI has three working groups, the first focusing on the mechanical and electrical details of the standard, the second focused on the flammable refrigerant details, and the third addressing potential conflicts with ASHRAE 15.

This was a three-day meeting, from March 23 to March 25, 2020, CSPC only attended on March 24, 2020.

This meeting focused on the flammable refrigerant requirements needed for the standard. Several working groups gave updates to their work. Topics of discussion included refrigerant sensor requirements, testing requirements for sensor locations, requirements for units or components that are normally installed outdoors, discussion on how to include packaged systems that are factory-charged with enough refrigerant to require detection and mitigation, discussion on terming self-contained and non-self-contained systems, and an ASHRAE 15 update.
