SUMMARY OF MEETING: The meeting discussed reinstatement and revisions of F1313 Standard Specification for Volatile N-Nitrosamine Levels in Rubber Nipples on Pacifiers. This specification was withdrawn in 2020 for failing to be reaffirmed in 2019, and was recently balloted for reapproval within ASTM. Participants discussed all comments and negatives received on the ballot, which included lack of clarity as to the scope of the rubber materials and the chemical substances covered by the specification, inaccurate or unclear text in the analytical methods, inconsistent use of terminology, and editorial changes. The work group chair will update the specification, which will be circulated for additional consideration and preparation for reballot.
