Four testing firms presented on the limitations they are experiencing due

to the pandemic. Even moving forward, limitations may be implimented that continue to hinder the ablity to test to the requirements of 16 C.F.R. section 1700.20 A formal proposal with suggested modifications to testing standard is forthcoming and will be submitted to CPSC staff within the week.
