SUMMARY OF MEETING:

Ms. King discussed reviewing products not covered by the traditional sleep products (i.e., cribs, bassinets, etc.) discussed in the CPSC SNPR. She indicated that the labeling for this standard should not put new requirements on those products already covered by a standard. She discussed how the current standards have some requirements in common, such as cribs and playards have a height requirement to prevent the occupant from climbing out and others have requirements unique to the product. Either way, she suggested looking at these across the board to be able to determine what should be added to this general standard. To begin the discussion, she asked about the upper age limit for this standard and the task group (TG) indicated that 12 months was an appropriate age limit because “infant” is defined as 12 months and younger. She also proposed that the suffocation warning must be included in this standard, but she hopes that the warning can be shorter and just get to the most important message. She asked that the TG members take a look at the comparisons and send her any suggestions. The meeting adjourned.
