Meeting Summary:

Ballot results were reviewed:

Item 001 (on non-mandatory language) received 3 negatives, 1 of which was administrative. The ballot item changed some informational wording (testing clarifications) to address ASTM preferred language for mandatory requirements (can to may, must to should). CPSC staff questioned changing must to should. One negative found persuasive so the item will be reballoted prior to fall meeting.

Item 002 (walker occupant leaning over edge) received 2 negatives, 1 of which was administrative. For the occupant leaning over edge test, the current wording allows the aluminum angle to be pitched downward. The new wording allows it to be horizontal. The non-administrative negative was withdrawn.

Item 003 (update on Table 1) passed with no comments or negatives

Item 004 (Section 7.6.1 on walker and dummy positioning) - No negatives and two comments. Thus, this item passed.

Item 005 (tip resistance clarification, Section 7.3.2.3), passed with no comments or negatives.

There were no task group reports.

The next meeting will be Nov 8-10 2021. Ballot items 002-004 will be held up for the reballot of item 001, which should go out to ballot before the fall meeting. After publication, ASTM will notify CPSC of the revision. The ad hoc language will be addressed at future meetings.
