This was a meeting for the CANENA working group looking to update UL/CSA 60335-2-40 from the current 3rd edition to the 4th edition. The next edition will be based on IEC 60335-2-40 6th Edition. The group is targeting completing a draft by July 2021. The draft standard needs to go to preliminary review by September 2021. The mechanical codes will require the draft ready for review by January 2022.

UL presented to the group on an AHRI research project which looked to characterize the impact of mitigation techniques for HVAC and refrigeration systems that contain flammable refrigerants in leak scenarios.
