Meeting Summary:

Ballot results - 3 ballots discussed:

1) F15 (21-01) Item 004, Lids on baby box – There were 3 negative votes related to two issues:

(a) baby box manufacturer explained lid is needed for structural integrity during shipping and no evidence having a lid is a hazard. And

(b) definition of lid needs clarity. At least one negative was found persuasive, so the ballot item will go back to task group.

2) F15 (21-01) Item 005, Water repellency – Two negative votes were cast because the proposed test is a fabric test. One negative was found persuasive, so the item will go back to the task group to investigate another test (Cobb Test) used for paper and paper board.

3) F15 (21-03) Item 002, Ad Hoc language – There was a lengthy discussion about potential conflict for compact bassinet language and in-bed sleeper language if a product can be considered both. There isn't an in-bed sleeper standard, yet, so as not to hold up the bassinet standard, the one negative vote was withdrawn and thus the ballot for Ad Hoc language passed.

Due to the length of time spent discussing the 3 ballots above, 2 older ballots: 1) Scope and 2) Side Height were not discussed.
