Summary of Meeting:

This a meeting of the UL STP 30 committee. The UL 30 STP is preparing a new draft UL 30 joint standard that incorporates requirements from the current UL 30, UL 1313, and ULC ORD-30 voluntary standards, which cover flammable liquid containers. The new draft UL 30 joint standard also includes a test method for flame mitigation devices.

Prior to the meeting, staff offered comments on the scope, definition of a safety can, and general requirements to UL based on a “clean” version of the draft.

The STP first reviewed comments from the UL chair before reviewing staff comments. The STP accepted most of staff’s editorial comments and staff’s proposal to establish a minimum container size. The STP requested that staff resubmit the other comments during the next ballot phase.

Staff updated the STP on the status of the CPSC contract to develop a FMD test method based on ASTM F3429.

UL intends to prepare a re-circulation ballot of the draft and submit to the STP by the end of May. The ballot will be open for 60 days.
