The Scope workgroup, led by Rachel Weintraub, met virtually with representatives of the Alzheimer's Association. The goal was to learn more about this brain disease and its impact on society. Members were given a brief overview of the disease, risk factors, how it progresses over a lifespan, and impact on families and caregivers. Association representatives reviewed several complications that arise when an individual living with Alzheimer's and dementia is living at home; this can include, in part, changes in care needs, behavior, and safety issues. This information presented will be provided to the subcommittee members and discussed with task group members at the next meeting.
