This meeting was held to review the joint task group work for STP 2075 and STP 9200. The STP 9200 is in the midst of adopting IEC 62990-1:2019, Workplace Atmospheres — Part 1: Gas detectors, Performance requirements of detectors for toxic gases. There is concern about the discrepancies between the scopes of this IEC document and UL 2075, which could cause confusion as to which standard applies. This joint task group for STP 2075 and STP 9200 has been formed to address this concern.

The task group chair presented the scope of the new standard and compared the related gas standards including UL 2075 in order to evaluate and establish the scope of the new UL standard. The STP discussed about technical definitions and provided the feedback to the task group chair. The STP chair will circulate the presentation to STP members for further review and comments.
