Summary of Meeting:

This was a working meeting for the task group revising ASTM F2517. The task group is considering proposing an updated functional test which currently focuses on testing senior's abilities to open gasoline containers.

The task group reviewed a marked-up draft of proposed revisions to the standard that the task group chair prepared with comments provided by staff offline. Staff actively contributed to discussions on the mark-up regarding the scope, definitions, requirements, child testing, and adult testing. This draft removes some ambiguities to the child testing requirements and allows for younger adult participants.

The task group agreed the draft is ready for the subcommittee to review. The group expects to forward the draft to the subcommittee in the near future for a one- or two-week review before sending to the main committee for ballot.

Someone from industry will ask CPSC compliance staff above the possibility of certifying to the next version of the standard before the Commission officially accepts that version.
