## **SUMMARY OF MEETING:**

The subcommittee group discussed a recent ballot and the three negative results to the proposed head entrapment test. The negatives concerned the feasibility of applying a force to the large head probe in the test. CPSC staff suggested reviewing the CPSC public playground handbook as it evaluates flexible openings by inserting a head probe in the potentially hazardous openings. Another attendee suggested reviewing the ASTM F833-21 *Standard Consumer Safety Performance Specification for Carriage and Strollers* for a similar head entrapment test. The subcommittee agreed to form a task group to review the stroller standard and the CPSC public playground handbook to determine the appropriate head probe insertion force.

Next Steps: CPSC staff will participate in the head entrapment task group. The subcommittee next meeting will be scheduled for the week of May 23, 2022.
