Summary of Meeting:

This was a meeting of the NFPA 30 Correlating Committee. The Correlating Committee was reviewing proposed revisions in the first draft of the next edition of NFPA 30 by the other NFPA 30 Committees for correlating issues.

The NFPA 30 Correlating Committee reviewed all proposed changes to be incorporated into the first draft of the next edition to NFPA 30. The committee wrote several notes, where appropriate. No notes were made pertaining to consumer products or flame mitigation devices. Many of the notes pertained to removing or transferring to NFPA 400 requirements for unstable liquids; the committee discussed submitting a memo to NFPA 400 as a public input. CPSC staff answered questions regarding the progress of requirements for flame mitigation devices in portable fuel containers.

The committee completed their work in preparation for the first draft of the next edition. NFPA staff plans to have the first draft report ready for public comment starting on March 22, 2022.
